Math: *Saxon Math 6/5*. Advanced math computations, measurement, fractions, graphing, coordinates, statistics, decimals.

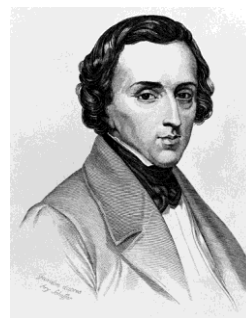
Science: Plant reproduction, flowers, atoms, complex/compound machines (related to ancient inventions), constellations (related to mythology), systems of human body
