

GUIDELINES FOR A ONE TIME REBATE DISTRIBUTION WITH A 50/50 SPLIT

For orders placed between July 2011 and April 8, 2012, those families opting to apply 50% of the rebate money to the Redeemer School Annual Fund *and* 50% of the rebate money to Redeemer School fees and tuition, the **fees and tuition portion** of the distribution will be made in the following order:

- (1) The rebate will be applied to any outstanding tuition and/or fees due from previous months.
- (2) The rebate will be applied to the families' activity fees for the 2012-2013 school year, which is due May 1, 2012.
- (3) If applicable, any remaining rebate will be applied to the final tuition payment in May 2012.
- (4) Once #1, #2, and #3 are paid *in full*, if there is still rebate money in your Scrip account it will be applied to the 2011-2012 Annual Fund in addition to the 50% already given.

*If a family has paid tuition annually, rebates will be distributed in the following order:

- (1) The rebate will be applied to any outstanding tuition and/or fees due from previous months.
- (2) The rebate will be applied to the families' activity fees for the 2012-2013 school year, which is due May 1, 2012.
- (3) Any remaining rebate will be applied to the 2011-2012 Annual Fund in addition to the 50% already given.

*If a family will *not* be returning to Redeemer School the 2012-2013 school year, rebates will be distributed in the following order:

- (1) The rebate will be applied to any outstanding tuition and/or fees due from previous months.
- (2) The rebate will be applied to the final tuition payment in May 2012.
- (3) Any remaining rebate will be applied to the 2011-2012 Annual Fund in addition to the 50% already given.

***All rebates earned from orders placed April 15, 2012 until May 31, 2012 will be distributed to the 2011-2012 Redeemer School Annual Fund.**

***No orders will be placed during June 2012.**

***If a family leaves Redeemer School *during* the 2011-2012 school year, all rebates will be forfeited to the 2011-2012 Redeemer School Annual Fund.**
